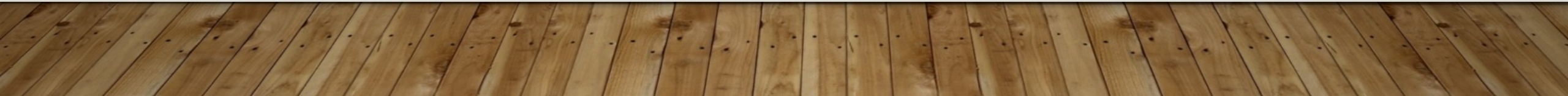

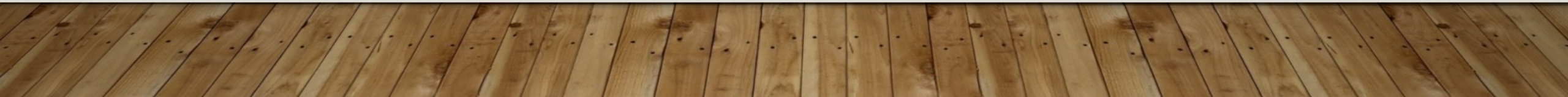

VISION 8: GOD'S FINAL JUDGEMENTS UPON THE EARTH (1-8)

- I. The Vision: The 4 Chariots (1-2)
 - A. The location – “Between the two mountains”
 - B. The chariots
- II. The Interpretation of the Vision (4-6)
 - A. The identity of those represented by the chariots – angelic emissaries tasked with a specific mission directly by the Lord
 - B. The direction of the chariots – North and South
- III. The Divine Mission: Judgement (7-8)
 - A. A request to patrol the earth (links back to the first vision)
 - B. The conclusion of the patrol (8)
 - 1. The mission of the angelic emissaries was to execute God's wrath against the invading nations
 - 2. The appeasement of God's wrath
 - 3. Parallel passages: Isa 66:15-16, Joel 3:12-14, Ezekiel 39

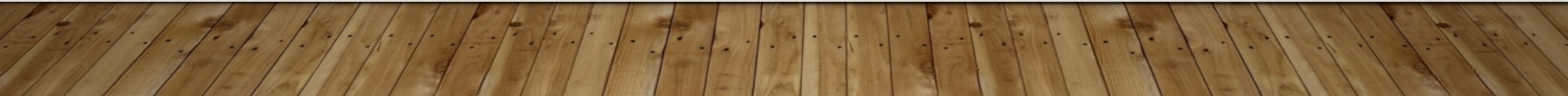
SUMMARY OF THE 8 VISIONS

1. Man among the Myrtle trees: God is with His people and is taking up Israel's cause
2. 4 horns: God will punish the nations who oppress Israel
3. Man with a measuring line: Jerusalem will be rebuilt and greatly blessed and protected by God.
4. Picture of Salvation and Cleansing: God will forgive sin and offers cleansing and restoration through the work of the Messiah
5. Lampstand and Olive trees: God will accomplish His purposes in Israel using divinely appointed servants fully resourced and empowered by the Holy Spirit.
6. The flying scroll: God will enact judgment upon individual sinners
7. The woman in the basket: God will one day act to purge the worldly sinful systems from Israel
8. The 4 chariots of God's wrath: God will judge the wicked nations of the earth and His wrath will be satisfied.

 - 1. The Messiah will occupy the offices of both priest and king (1 Tim 2:5-6)
 - 2. Joshua's name – "YHWH Saves" - a foreshadowing of Jesus
 - B. The proclamation (12-15)
 - 1. The identity of the Messiah – "Branch" – i.e. shoot
 - 2. The accomplishments of the Messiah:



THE CROWNING OF THE KING! (9-15)

- I. The offering and the crown (9-11a)
- II. The crowning of Joshua: a foreshadowing of the Messiah (11b-13)
 - A. Joshua crowned (11b)
 - B. The proclamation (12-15)
 - 1. The identity of the Messiah – “Branch” – i.e. shoot
 - 2. The accomplishments of the Messiah:
 - a) He will build the Millennial temple (12b-13a)
 - b) He will be greatly honored (13b) – Phil 2:9-11
 - c) He will sit on the throne of Israel (13c)
 - d) He will be both Priest and King (13d)
 - e) The foundation and distinctive of Jesus’s priestly and kingly offices will be the gospel of peace (13e)
 - f) He will bring non-Jewish people together with Israel to build the temple (15)
 - C. The crown was to be placed in the temple for remembrance (14)
 - D. The command to obey (15b) – Deut 18:1-2
