I. What is church membership?

Definitions

Long

"Church membership is a formal relationship between a church and a Christian characterized by the church's affirmation and oversight of a Christian's discipleship and the Christian's submission to living out his or her discipleship in the care of the church."

Short

- A Christian officially submitting and belonging to a biblical local church

II. Where is membership in the Bible?

A. Membership "Rosters"

Acts 2:41-42 ⁴¹ So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls. ⁴² They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

B. "Ministry Lists"

 Timothy 5:9 9 A widow is to be put on the list only if she is not less than sixty years old, having been the wife of one man,

C. Removal from membership:

1 Corinthians 5:1-2 ¹ It is actually reported that there is immorality among you, and immorality of such a kind as does not exist even among the Gentiles, that someone has his father's wife. ² You have become arrogant and have not mourned instead, so that the one who had done this deed would be removed from your midst.

D. Membership "transfers"

Romans 16:1 ¹ I commend to you our sister Phoebe, who is a servant of the church which is at Cenchrea;
