The enemies will be made to stagger (v2a)

Jerusalem will be a heavy stone that severely injures its enemies (v3a)

The strength of the enemies will be made utterly useless (v4)

Israel's leaders will acknowledge, in humility, the strength of their God (v5)

God will consume the enemies by fire while protecting His people, to His own glory (vv6-7)

The people of Israel will be given great capabilities by the Lord in that day (v8) God will destroy all nations in that day who oppose Israel (v9)

Ezekiel 36:25–27 ²⁴ "For I will take you from the nations, gather you from all the lands and bring you into your own land. ²⁵ "Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. ²⁶ "Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ "I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.

Isaiah 53:4—7 ⁴Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted. ⁵But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed. ⁶All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him. ⁷He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth.

All of Israel will mourn bitterly for having rejected and pierced Christ (12:10c-14)

The ultimate cleansing from sin (13:1-9)

A fountain will be opened for Israel to remove sin and impurity (v1)

Idols, false prophets, and Satanic influences will all be removed (vv2-6)

The striking of the coming Messiah is a sovereign decree of God, after which a remnant will be saved (13:7-9)
