- **#4 <u>Send out</u>** Your arrows and confuse them.
- **#5 -** 7 Stretch forth Your hand from on high;
- **#6- Rescue me** and **deliver me** out of great waters,

A. Properly Responding to God's Care vs 9-10

B. Perpetually Relying on God's Care vs 11

11 Rescue me and deliver me out of the hand of aliens, Whose mouth speaks deceit And whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood.

IV. Expecting God's Special Care for His People Psalm 144:12-15

A. Three "Presumptuous" Requests of God

#1 - 12 Let our sons in their youth be as grown-up plants,

3 - 14 Let our cattle bear Without mishap

*Presumptuous? vs 3-4 vs 12-14 Deut 8:1-10 And <u>our</u> daughters as corner pillars fashioned as for a palace; # 2 - 13 Let our garners be full, furnishing every kind of produce, And <u>our</u> flocks bring forth thousands and ten thousands in our fields; and without loss, Let there be no outcry in our streets!



B. Two Perfect Realities of God's People vs 15

#1 - 15 How blessed are the people who are so situated;

#2 - How blessed are the people whose God is the Lord
