


- Cultural and family apply pressure to remain Catholic


Speak The Truth in Love


- The true church is made up of all who have been baptized by the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 12:13).

- God does not make sinners alive in Christ until they know they are dead in their sins; all sins are mortal (Rom. 6:23).






2. Declare the Sufficiency of Jesus He died once for all sin for all time; there are no more offerings for sin (Heb. 10:10, 12, 18). He is able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him (Heb. 7:25). He accomplished every thing necessary to save sinners and then cried out in victory "It is finished" (John 19:30).




3. Get the Gospel Right

- It is eternal the same message for every generation (Rev. 14:6).
- It is exclusive all other faiths and religions are false
- It is according to Scripture alone no other source (2 Tim. 3:15, 1 Cor. 15:1-4).
- It has divine power to save those who believe it (Rom. 1:16).
- It is of grace those who add anything to it stand condemned (Gal. 1:6-9; Rom. 11:6).



Grace and Works Are Mutually Exclusive in Justification You can DO What Jesus has nothing to save DONE to save yourself. sinners gives all the glory to God and Any attempt to do His saving grace. so nullifies justifying All boasting is in grace and insults Jesus Christ and Jesus and His all-His righteousness. sufficient work. 3. Christ is the Only Savior. He is the eternal God incarnate, born of a virgin and lived a perfect life. Sinners can be saved by His unique, historical, unrepeatable, substitutionary death and His glorious resurrection from the dead.

4. Sinners Must Repent and Believe the Gospel Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation (2 Cor. 7:10). Repentance for forgiveness of sins must be proclaimed in Christ's name (Luke 24:47). Everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins (Acts 10:43).

4. Define the Substitutionary **Atonement of Christ**

(2 Cor. 5:21)

"He was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed" (Isaiah 53:5).

"Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous" (1 Pet. 3:15)

We must tell Catholics...

they must read God's Word they have broken God's Law they are condemned by God's justice they deserve God's wrath they need God's mercy their only hope - substitionary atonement of God's Son

5. Teach Antith vically

The apostles contrasted the impact of believing God's truth instead of Satan Lies

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith, and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God, not by works, so that no one can boast" (Eph. 2:8-9).


6. Pray

- for the salvation of those blinded by religious deception (Rom. 10:1)
- for words to be given to fearlessly make known the Gospel (Eph. 6:19)
- for God to **open doors and hearts** for us to proclaim Christ clearly (Col. 4:2-4)
- for wisdom and to make the most of every opportunity (Col. 4:5-6)





Questions to Ask Catholics
