Introduction

Context:

- 1. Every part of the Bible is "God-breathed" and "useful" because God is intentional in every aspect of relating to His people.
- 2. There are multiple themes that run throughout the Bible from Genesis to Revelation, and today we'll see one of those through the construction of Solomon's temple.

Theme: God the Father has always desired to dwell with His people in a personal manner, and does so in varying ways throughout history.


I. The Timeframe (v. 1)

A. Four Years spent in Preparation

- 1. Solomon was focused on the work to come
- 2. "It is not time lost which is spent in composing ourselves for the work of God, and disentangling ourselves from everything which might distract or divert us." MH

Application:

- What is God preparing you for during this time in your life?
- Are we being impatient in wanting to move forward with God's plans?



II. Description of the Temple (v. 2-10)


A. The Temple's Predecessor: the Tabernacle

- 1. Detailed plans given to Moses (Ex 25:9)
- 2. What was the purpose? (Ex 25:8, 40:34-38, 29:34-35)



B. The Temple

- 1. Size of the Temple (v. 2-3)
- 2. Functionality of the Temple (v. 4-6a, 8-10)
- 3. Sanctity of the Temple (v. 6b-7)






II. Description of the Temple (v. 2-10)

C. The Bigger Picture of the Temple

- 1. The Garden (Gen 3:8)
- 2. The Tabernacle
- 3. The Temple(s)
- 4. The Messiah! Jesus (John 2:18-21, Heb 10:19-22)
- 5. The Church!
 - > It's you! (1 Cor 3:16, 1 Cor 6:19)
 - > It's us = the church! (Eph 2:19-22, 2 Cor 6:16)

Application:

- We should understand and appreciate God's Heartfelt Desire to dwell with His people
- Are we living in a way that shows God's visible presence to those around us?



III. God's Conditional Promise (v. 11-13)


A. God outlines an IF...THEN... situation

- 1. Family blessings to David were conditional (1 Kings 2:4)
- 2. Personal blessings for Solomon were conditional (1 Kings 3:14)
- 3. National blessings for Israel were conditional (1 Kings 9:6-7)

B. God's personal Presence does not equal Perpetual Blessings

Application

 Our salvation is unconditional based on God's mercy and grace, but the quality of our relationship is conditional on our obedience/idolatry



IV. The Temple's Interior (v. 14-38)

- A. Cherubim: Guardians of God's Presence (v. 23-28)
 - 1. Present in every iteration of the Temple in Scripture




Application:

- If Cherubim are present, proclaiming and protecting God's Holiness in every temple, and we are the Temple...then they are with the Church as well.

- A. Internal Magnificence and Costliness (v. 14-22, 29-38)
 - 1. Displayed God's Holiness (1 Chron 22:14, 29:3)
 - 2. Displayed the Cost of our Salvation (Mark 15:34)

The Final Iteration: God's Goal



A. Rev 21:22

"And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb."

B. God will restore a fully-realized, personal Father-to-child, face-to-face relationship that requires no limited presence!
