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


Proposition Questions:

Question: How does the Creator of the Universe prepare his disciples for the dangers of ministry?

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




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- IV. The Scenes. What are the major theological threads, themes, and teachings woven together in the next 4 vignettes?


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VI. Jesus Serves His disciples. He warns them of the many minefields in ministry and the necessity of being spiritually prepared. (8:10-26)
