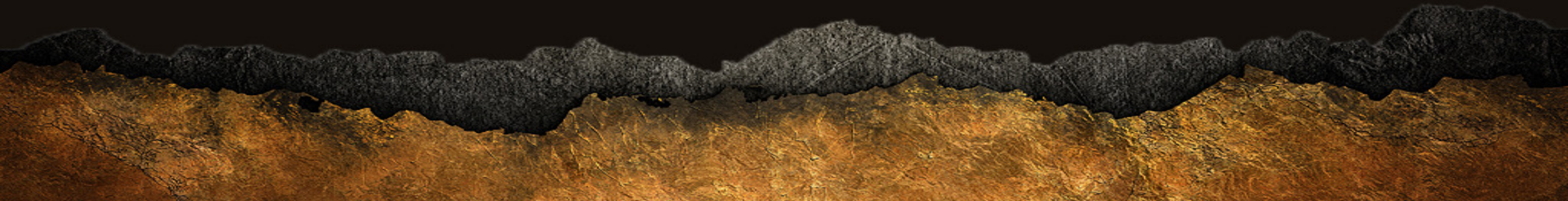

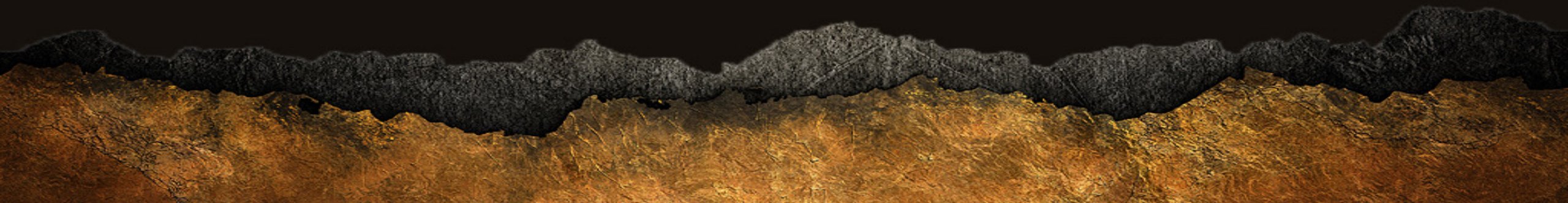

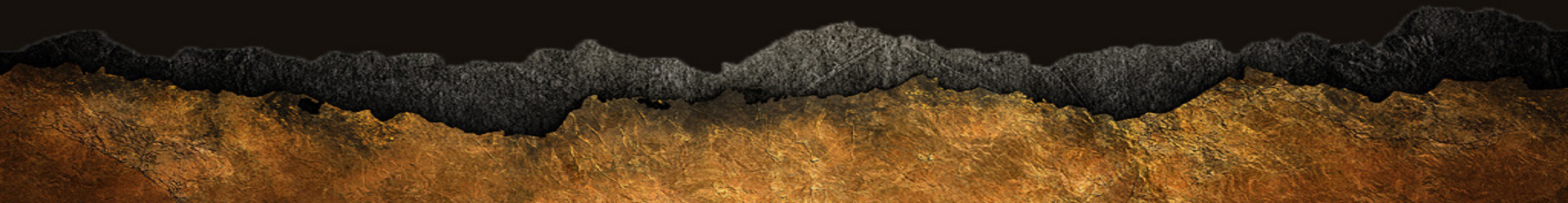

Zabud, son of Nathan	Senior Adviser
Ahishar	Steward of the Royal Estate
Adoniram ("Adoram"), son of Abda	Secretary of Labor
