- a. Spiritual Childhood: the Start of the Christian Life (12; 13c)
 - The true Christian loves God because of the forgiveness of his sins and a new relationship with God as Father.
- b. Spiritual Adulthood: the Goal of the Christian Life (13a; 14a)
 - The true Christian pursues a mature knowledge of and love for the Father and the Son, through the Holy Spirit.
