- Origin of the fruit (John 15)
- Do we have responsibility? YES!
- What is it? How do plant the seeds? "Walk by the Spirit".
 (Psalm 119)
- How does it work? (2 Corinthians 3:18)

Galatians 5:22 - Love

- Contrary to Popular belief... Love is not a feeling.
- Clarification... (1 Cor. 13:4-7)
- Christ the example... (Rom. 5:8; Phil. 2:7-8; Jn. 15:13)
- Command... (Mark 12:28-31)

Galatians 5:22 - Joy

- Contrary to Popular belief... Joy has nothing to do with your circumstances.
- Clarification... (James 1:2)
- Christ the example... (Hebrews 12:2; John 16:20-22)
- Command... (Philippians 4:4)

Galatians 5:22 - Peace

- Contrary to Popular belief... Peace is not the absence of strife.
- Clarification... (Rom. 5:1; Rom. 8:28; Matt. 6:26-30)
- Christ the example... (Is. 9:6; Mark 4:37-38)
- Command... (Philippians 4:6-7)

Galatians 5:22 - Patience

- Contrary to Popular belief... Patience is not being passive.
- Clarification... Patience is long-suffering, forgiveness, and love.
- Christ the example... (2 Pet. 2:9; 1 Tim. 1:15-16)
- Command... (1 Thess. 5:4)
