Three Reminders of the Saving Heart of God:

- I. He Hears Humble Prayers (1–2)
- II. He Controls Difficult Circumstances (3–6)
- III. He Saves Repentant Sinners (7–10)

2. ...instructive of how we should respond when disciplined for our sin.
3. ...a picture of our salvation.
4. ...a picture of Jesus our Savior. (Matthew 12:38–40)
