Main Idea

An authentic follower of Christ,

- Recognizes His care, concern and compassion for the individual AND His power over disease and death, and
- Display's fearless faith in him in the journey of discipleship



1. Faith Displayed in the **CENTER** of a large crowd (vv. 21-24)

Slice 1 – Jesus's companions try to Seize him (20-21)

Meat – The religious leaders accuse Jesus of being in league with Beelzebul (22-30)

Slice 2 – Jesus' family Seeks Him (31-35)



Mark 4:1-20

Slice 1 – Parable of the Sower (1-9)

Meat – Purpose of Parables (10-13)

Slice 2 – Explanation of the Parable of the Sower (14-20)



Mark 5:21-43

Slice 1 – Jairus pleads with Jesus to save his daughter (21-24)


Meat – Woman with a hemorrhage touches Jesus (25-34)

Slice 2 – Jesus raises Jairus's daughter (35-43)

The 'unnamed' woman

- The word used for 'suffer' or endure in vs. 26, is used only for this woman and Jesus (Mark 8:31 and 9:12) In Mark.
- The word used for 'affliction' is the Greek word 'mastix' which is also translated as 'scourged' and is used in last of Jesus's passion prediction (Mark 10:34).
- The word used for 'made well' is the word 'sozo.' A term used in the NT for being made well from sin, or saved from sin.
- Jesus and this woman are the only two examples that Mark shares where there is a shedding/flow of blood involved (Mark 14:24)

3. Faith Displayed in the **COMFORT** of a home (vv. 35 -43)

4. The Lack of Faith displayed in the **CENTER** of a crowd (6:1-6)



Lessons

- 1. Our bodies are important too
- 2. Our Lord makes time for the individual
- 3. Our Lord is sovereign over death and disease
- 4. Our Faith has value not because of the intensity with which we display it, but because of the object of our faith i.e. the Lord Jesus Christ
