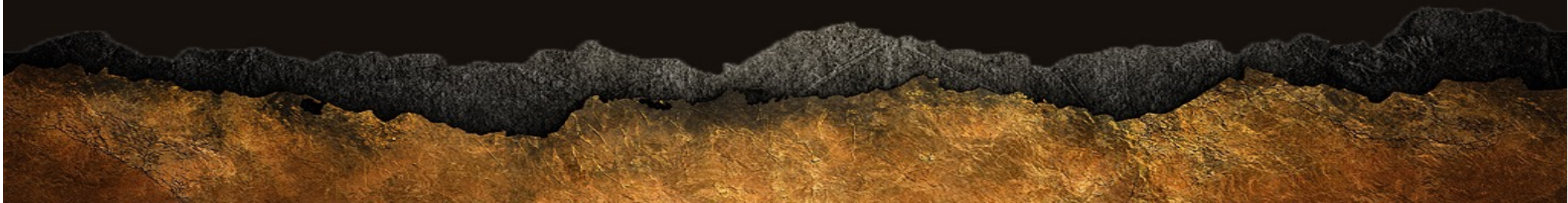

Unrepentant sin has disastrous consequences.



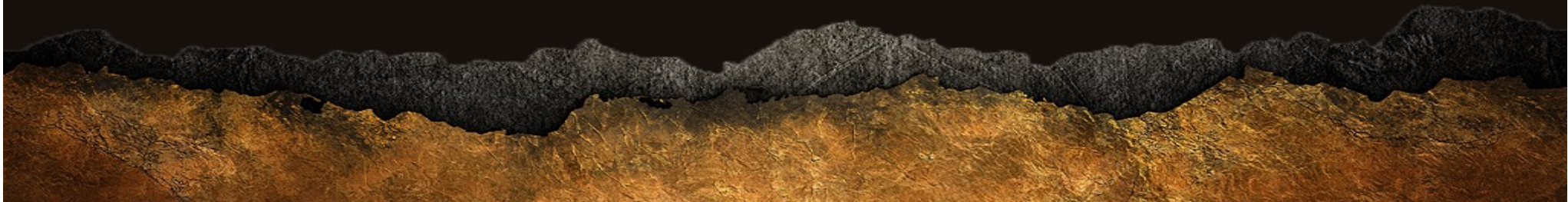

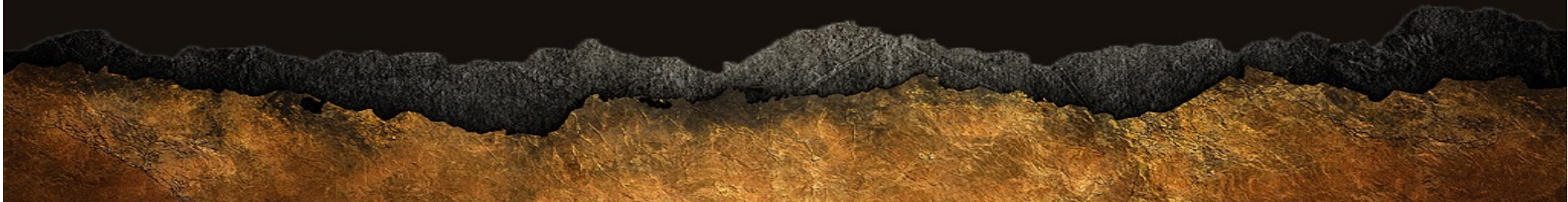
