Theme Statement of Proverbs:

"The **fear of the LORD** is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction." (1:7)

Key Chapter Verses:

""My son, keep my words and treasure my commandments within you. Keep my commandments and live, and (keep) my teaching as the apple of your eye" (7:1-2).

"The one who commits adultery with a woman is lacking sense; He who would destroy himself does it" (6:32).

Theme:

Every believer, without exception, must decide his or her resolve to pursue this lifelong task of obtaining wisdom. Grasping wisdom takes work and tireless effort. Like mining gold with a pick ax, the believer develops deep spiritual callouses on his hands in his daily, digging efforts. All efforts are motivated by the "Fear of the Lord," and lead the believer onward on the righteous path while tightly grasping two foundational truths found in Proverbs 3:5-6.

- 1) Trust God's Word as your final authority. Verse 5. "Trust in the Lord with all your Heart."
- 2) Obey God's Word as your practical authority. Verse 6. "In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will make your **Paths Straight**."
