The Wrath of God

- Cairns: "the settled opposition of God's nature against evil, his holy displeasure against sinners, and the punishment he justly metes out to them on account of their sins."
- Packer: "God's resolute action in punishing sin. It is as much the expression of a personal, emotional attitude of the Triune Jehovah as is his love to sinners: it is the active manifesting of his hatred of irreligion and moral evil."
- Hodge: God's "determination to punish sin."

- 1. Fear God (Mt. 10:28; Luke 12:5).
