


Revelation 16

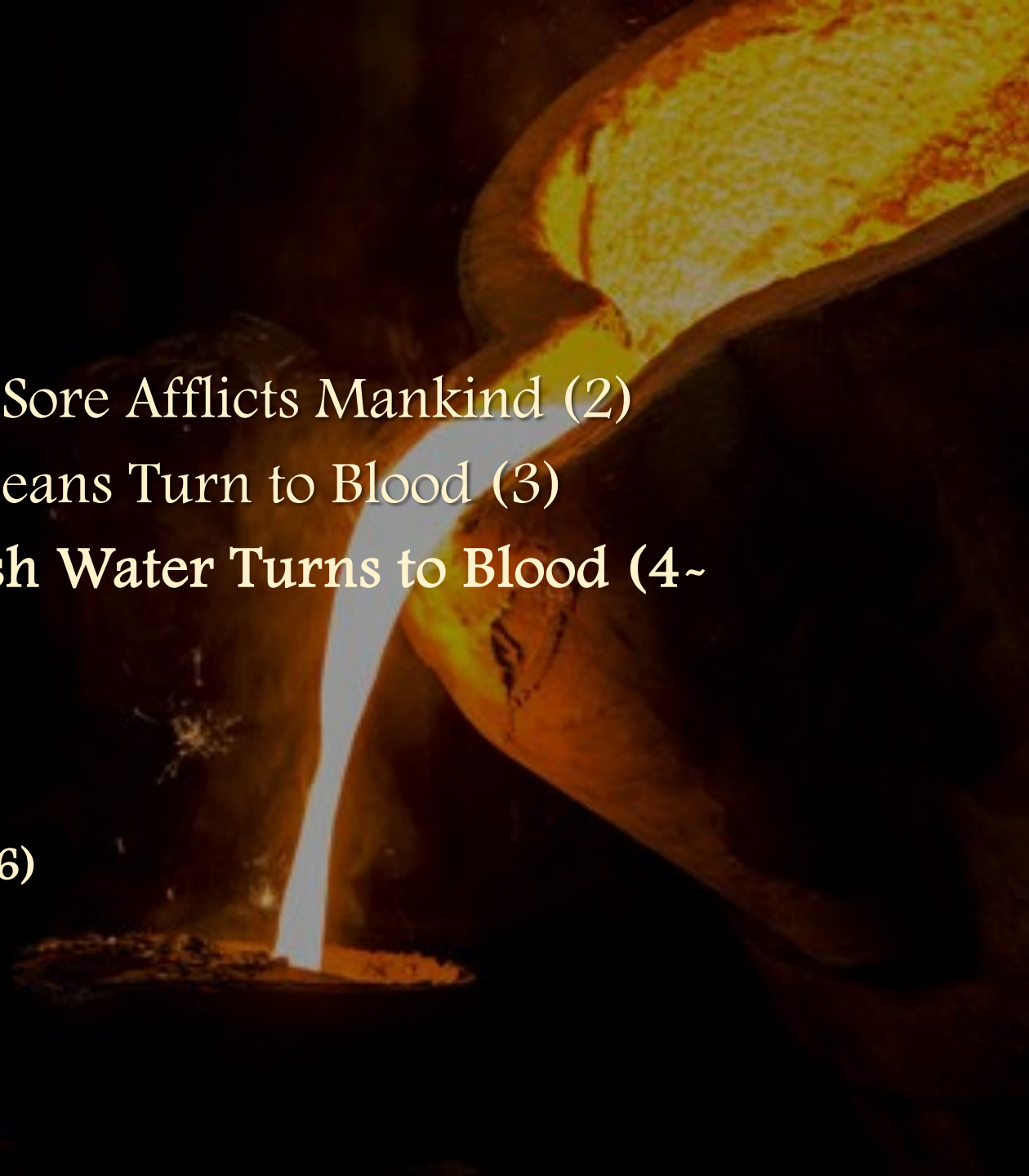



The Lessons for Us

1. God's final judgments will be entirely righteous and perfectly fitted to the crime (Ex. 21:23~25; Gal. 6:7; Obadiah 15).
2. God will judge all unbelievers with perfect justice (Rom. 2:4~6; Rev. 20:12).
3. Christ endured God's justice for every believer, so we receive only grace (Col. 2:13~14; Rev. 1:5; 5:9~10).
