Ch. 16 describes a series of staccato-like, powerful, severe divine judgments that finish God's wrath and prepare for the Second Coming of Jesus Christ.






God's Relationship with Evil

- 1. God is not the source of evil (Is. 6:3).
- 2. God does not tempt man to do evil (Jam. 1:13).
- 3. God does not force man do evil (Jam. 1:14~15) he is drawn away and enticed by his own cravings.
- 4. God holds the sinner responsible for his sin (Ex. 34:7).

Regarding people's sinful actions, God...

- 1. Prevents (Gen. 20:6; Lk. 22:31)
- 2. Permits (Rom. 1:24, 28)
- 3. Limits (2 Th. 2:7)
- 4. Directs (Gen. 50:20; Acts 2:23; 4:27~28)
