- 3. Rulers contemporaneous with Antichrist who rule during the Tribulation
- 4. Seven Gentile world empires

#### Lessons

- 1. All false religion is satanic.
  - Satan is always its ultimate source (Eph. 2:2).
  - Demons create, energize, and are worshipped through all false religions (Dt. 32:16-17; 1 Cor. 10:20).
  - False teachers and false prophets are the human instruments that propagate demonic religion (1 Tim. 4:1-2).
- 2. God hates all false religion and will destroy it (Rev. 17:16-17).

#### Lessons

- 3. God will not share His glory with any other object of worship (ls. 42:8).
- 4. One day, God alone will be worshiped and glorified (Rev. 21:3, 8, 22-23; 22:3, 15).
- 5. God controls and directs even the evil, self-serving actions of Satan, demons, human rulers, and every human being to accomplish His sovereign purpose (Rev. 17:17).
