The Duties of the Kinsman Redeemer

- 1. To buy back land a needy relative had sold under duress, to ensure that property never passed out of the family (Lev. 25:25-30).
- 2. To buy the freedom of those who had sold themselves into slavery because of poverty (Lev. 25:47-55).
- 3. To ensure justice was done in a lawsuit involving a relative (Job 19:25; Ps. 119:154; Jer. 50:34).
- 4. To track down and ensure the legal execution of murderers of near relatives (Num. 35:12, 19-27).
- 5. To receive restitution on behalf of a deceased victim of crime (Num. 5:8).
