- B. PAUL WARNS THEM TO FLEE TEACHERS WHO DENY THE TRUTH OF THE RESURRECTION.

"How are the dead raised? And with what kind of body do they come?"

PAUL'S ENLIGHTENING EXPLANATION

- B. THE CHANGE WILL BE SUDDEN. (V. 52)
- C. THE CHANGE WILL BE COMPLETE. (V. 52-53)
- D. THE CHANGE WILL BE VICTORIOUS (V. 54-57)

PAUL'S CONFIDENT EXHORTATION

- 1. BELIEVER SHOULD BE PERSISTENT.
- 2. BELIEVERS SHOULD BE PRODUCTIVE.
- 3. BELIEVERS SHOULD BE POISED.

APPLICATION

- RECOGNIZE THAT OUR HOPE (CERTAINTY) IS IN THE RISEN SAVIOR JESUS CHRIST. TO HOPE IN ANYTHING ELSE IS WORTHLESS.
- REHEARSE THE TRUTH OF THE RESURRECTION AND LET IT NOURISH YOU SO THAT YOU REMAIN STEADFAST.
- WE KNOW HOW THE STORY ENDS, BUT WE DON'T KNOW WHEN IT ENDS.

 SHARE THE GOSPEL TODAY! YOUR LABOR IS NOT IN VAIN.
- LET YOUR ACHES AND YOUR WEEDS REMIND YOU THAT A DAY IS COMING WHEN YOU WILL PUT ON A NEW RESURRECTION BODY.

IF WE REALLY BELIEVE...

"IF WE REALLY BELIEVE AND IF WE ARE TRULY THANKFUL THAT OUR RESURRECTION IS SURE, THAT WE WILL BE TRANSFORMED FROM THE PERISHABLE, DISHONORABLE, WEAK, NATURAL, MORTAL, AND EARTHY, TO THE IMPERISHABLE, GLORIOUS, POWERFUL, SPIRITUAL, IMMORTAL, AND HEAVENLY - WE SHOULD THEREFORE PROVE OUR ASSURANCE AND OUR THANKFULNESS BY BEING STEADFAST, IMMOVABLE, ALWAYS ABOUNDING IN THE WORK OF THE LORD."
