2 Chronicles 22:3–4 ³He also walked in the ways of the house of Ahab, for his mother was his counselor to do wickedly. ⁴He did evil in the sight of the LORD like the house of Ahab, for they were his counselors after the death of his father, to his destruction.

Jehu is Anointed King of Israel 2 Kings 9:1-13

- Elisha sends a younger prophet to secretly anoint Jehu as king over Israel (vv1-6)
- Jehu is instructed to wipe out the house of Ahab and is given a prophecy concerning Jezebel (vv7-10)
- Jehu tells his fellow captains what the prophet said (vv11-13)

Jehu Assassinates Joram and Ahaziah 2 Kings 9:14-29

- Jehu travels to find Joram (vv14-20)
- Joram and Ahaziah discover Jehu's plan (vv21-23)
- Jehu kills Joram and has his body thrown in Naboth's field (vv24-26)

1 Kings 21:19b–24 ¹⁹...Thus says the LORD, "In the place where the dogs licked up the blood of Naboth the dogs will lick up your blood, even yours....

21Behold, I will bring evil upon you, and will utterly sweep you away, and will cut off from Ahab every male... ²⁴The one belonging to Ahab, who dies in the city, the dogs will eat, and the one who dies in the field the birds of heaven will eat."

Jehu Assassinates Joram and Ahaziah 2 Kings 9:14-29


- Jehu travels to find Joram (vv14-20)
- Joram and Ahaziah discover Jehu's plan (vv21-23)
- Jehu kills Joram and has his body thrown in Naboth's field (vv24-26)
- Jehu then kills Ahaziah, but he is buried in Jerusalem (vv27-29)




The Prophecy of Jezebel's Death is Fulfilled 2 Kings 9:30-37


- Jehu meets and kills Jezebel (vv30-33)
- The prophecy concerning Jezebel is perfectly fulfilled (vv34-37)


1 Kings 21:23 Of Jezebel also has the LORD spoken, saying, 'The dogs will eat Jezebel in the district of Jezreel.'
















The Evil Acts of Athaliah to be Queen of Judah 2 Chronicles 22:10-12
