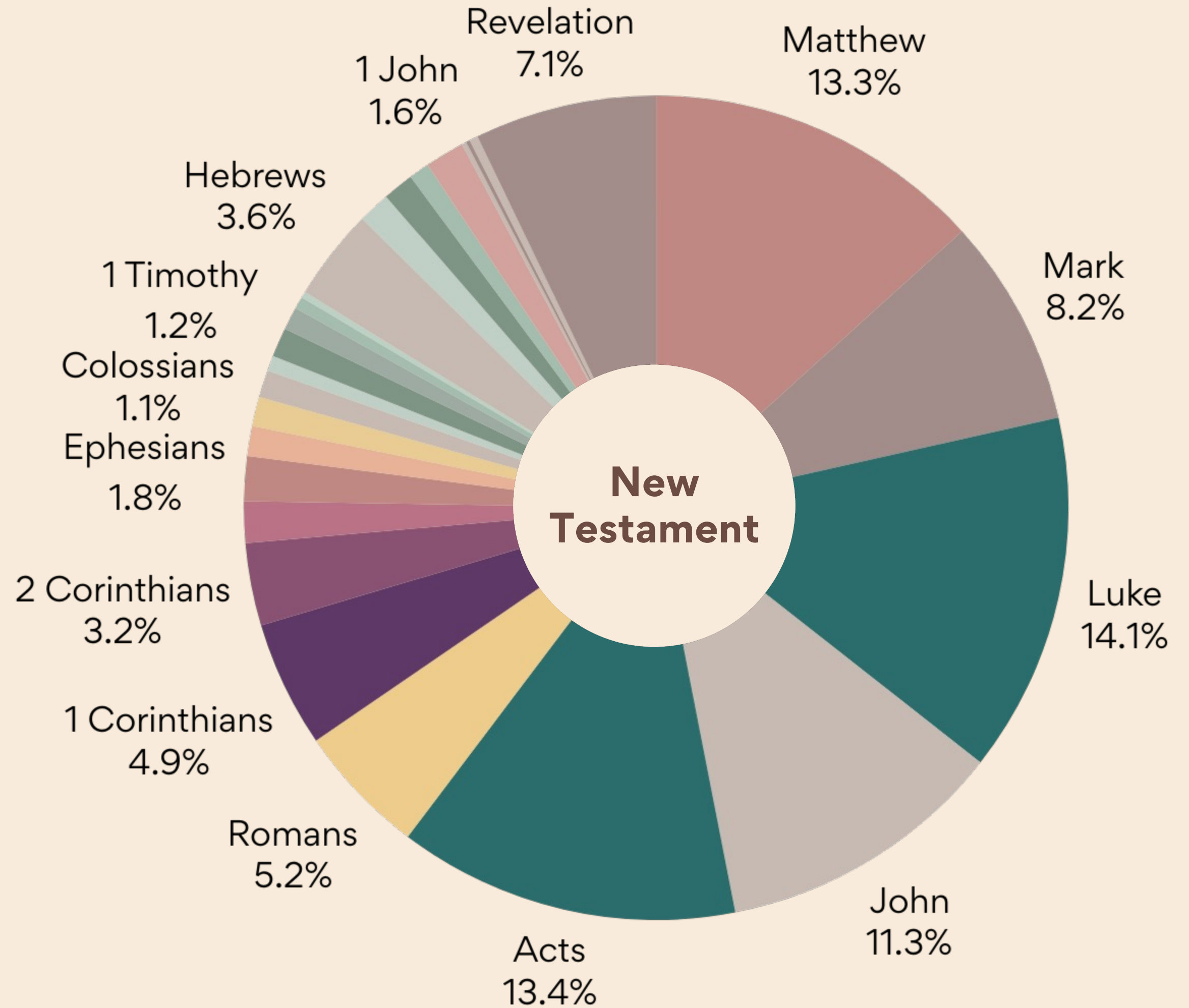

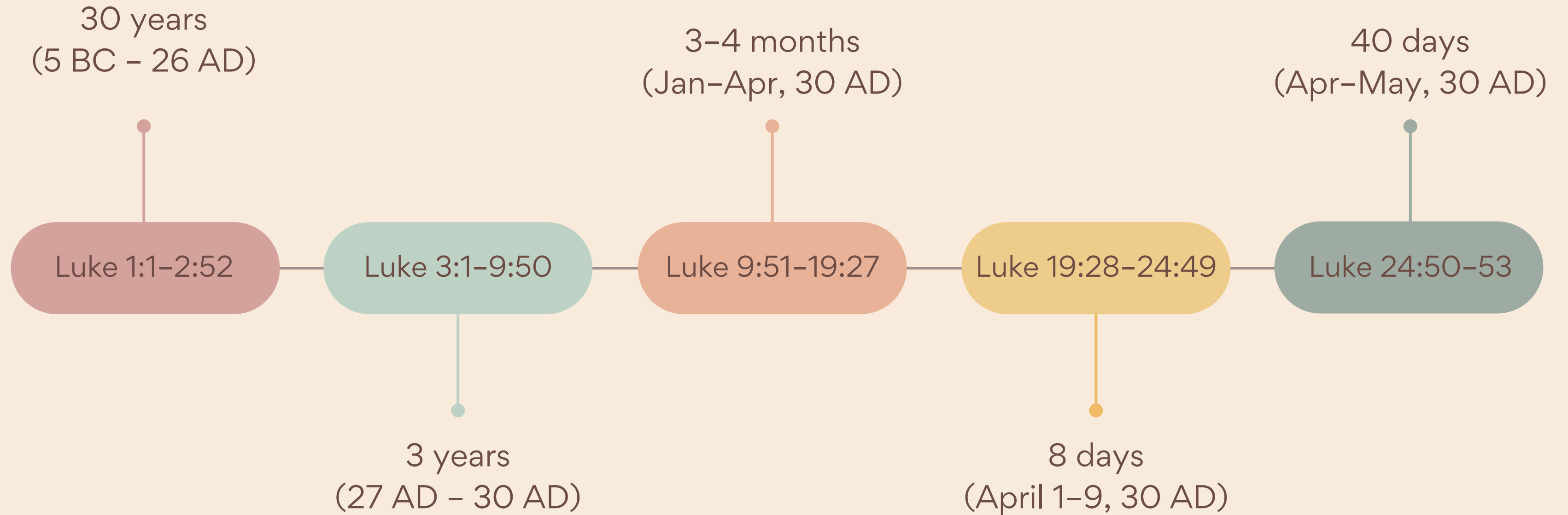

Timeline of Luke



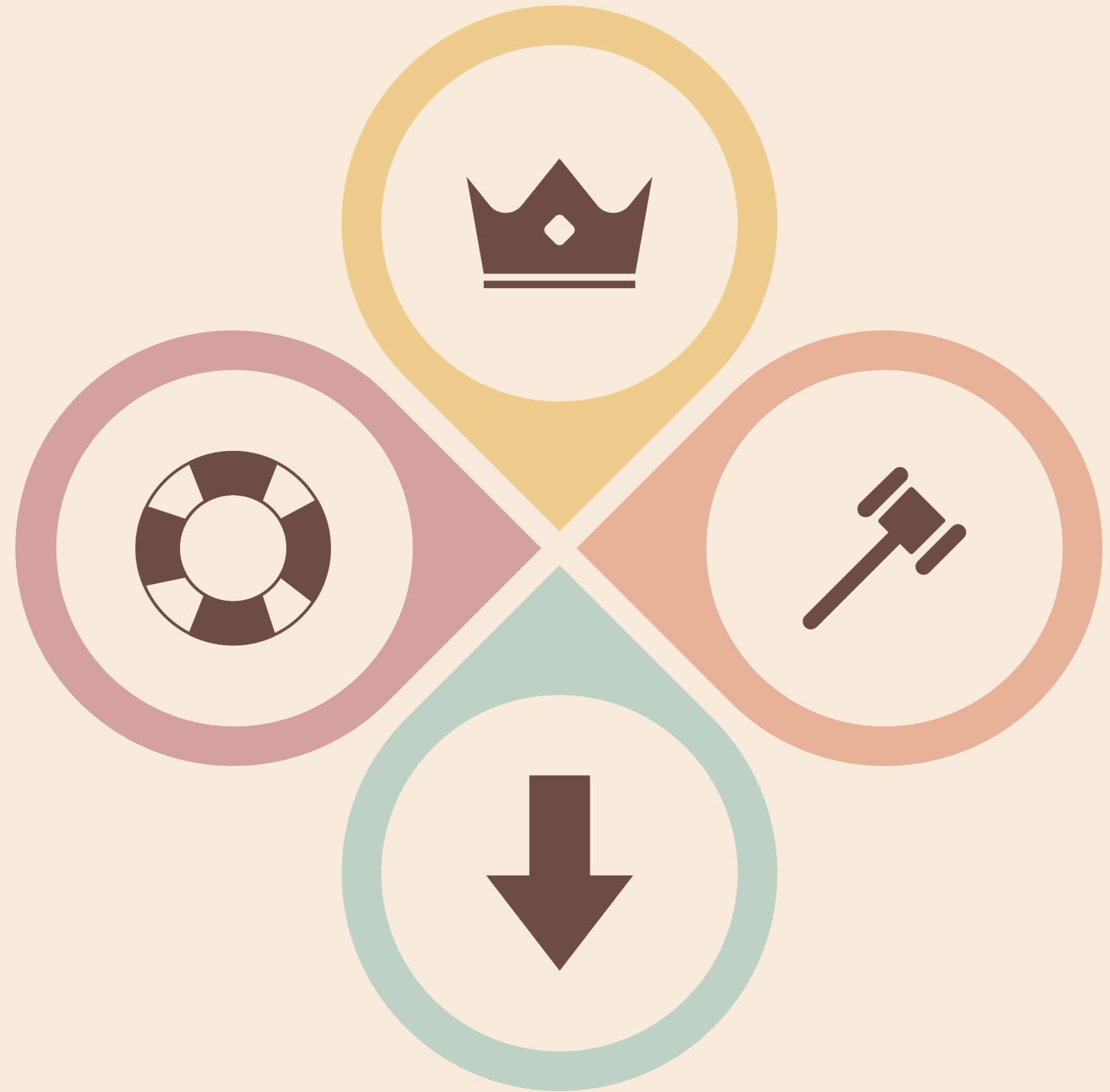

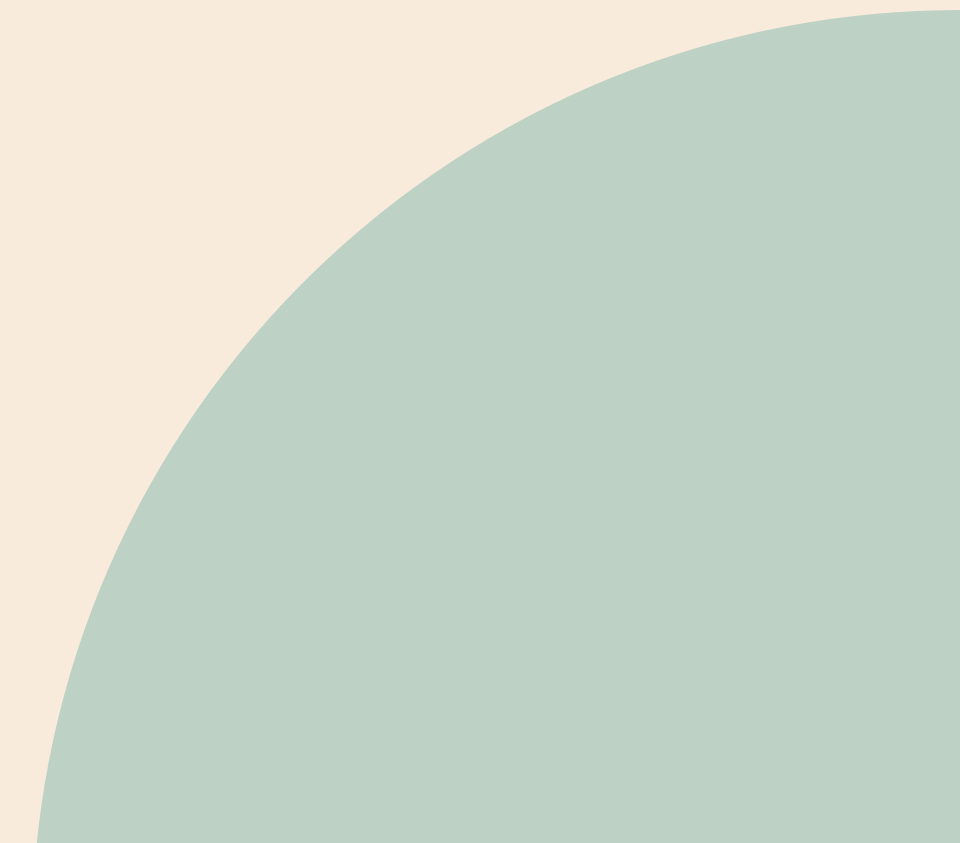
