The Difference between Teaching & Preaching

- The Greek terms are often used synonymously.
- 1. What one Gospel labels as "preaching" another gospel at times labels as "teaching" (e.g., Mt. 4:23; Mk. 1:39; Lk. 4:44).
- 2. Even within the same Gospel, the same activity is called "teaching" (Mk. 1:21; Lk. 4:15) and "preaching" (Mk. 1:38; Lk. 4:44).
- 3. The two words are even used synonymously in the same verse (Mt. 11:1; Lk. 20:1; Acts 5:42; 15:35; 28:31; Rom. 2:21; 2 Tim. 4:2).
- 4. The responsibility of NT elders is both teaching *and* preaching (Eph. 4:11; 1 Tim. 3:2; 2 Tim. 4:2).
- Teaching is the systematic instruction in God's Word.
- Preaching is the attitude, disposition, or manner of the messenger: he
 is to speak, announce, or teach as a herald, speaking with authority.

Four Primary Reasons for Jesus' Healing Ministry

- 1. To prove His divine identity (Jn. 5:36; 7:31; 10:24-25, 38; 14:11; 20:30-31)
- 2. To establish His credibility as a divine messenger of revelation (Acts 2:22)
- 3. To prove He was the promised Messiah (Mt. 8:17; cf. ls. 53:4; Mt. 11:3-5)
- 4. To demonstrate God's heart of compassion (Lk. 7:13; Jn. 14:9)
