Accusations Against Paul

1. He is Weak and Unimpressive (2 Cor. 10:10a)
2. He is NOT a True Apostle (2 Cor. 11:5)
3. He is Unskilled in Speech (2 Cor. 10:10b; 11:6a)
4. He is Uncaring (2 Cor. 11:7)
5. He Suffers too much (2 Cor. 11:23-30)
6. He is Deceitful and Manipulative (2 Cor. 12:17-18)
7. He is NOT Spiritually Powerful

Lesson Theme:

True gospel ministry is validated not by human greatness but by Christ-honoring suffering for His name.
