Our Most Intimate Relationship

John 15:1-11

Theme: Believers in the church age are called to remain in intimate relationship with Jesus Christ.

On the night before his crucifixion, Jesus uses a parable to illustrate five components of abiding in Him, that should drive believers to persevere in their obedience:

- I. The Roles in Abiding (vs. 1-3)
- II. The Requirement of Abiding (vs. 4a)
- III. The Results of Abiding (vs. 4b-8)
- IV. The Route to Abiding (vs. 9-10)
- V. The Reasons for Abiding (vs. 11)

Small Group Questions

- 1. What does it mean to "abide" in Christ? What are some common misconceptions about what this means? How would a professing believer's daily life look different if he *did* or *did not* abide in Christ?
- 2. What does pruning look like in the believer's life? How do you typically respond in times of pruning?
- 3. How ought you think about your spiritual accomplishments ("fruit"), particularly in light of vs. 3-4?
- 4. How ought we respond, emotionally and practically, in light of the fact that Jesus loves us to the same measure that the Father loves Him?
