



Background

In Scripture, we learn of Christ and see His glory revealed:

In the New Testament

- Historically in the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, John), historical account of the incarnation and life of Jesus from multiple perspectives
- Theologically in Acts thru the Epistles, which more fully detail the meaning and theological significance of Jesus' life, death, resurrection, and ascension
- Eschatologically in Revelation, which reveals Christ in His future glory

In the Old Testament

■ Prophetically — throughout the Old Testament, which provides revelations of, and revelations concerning, Christ before His incarnation

Reasons for Studying Christ in the Old Testament

- 1. Christ Himself declared that He is revealed in the Old Testament (e.g., Matthew 22:41-46, John 5; Luke 4; Luke 16; Luke 24)
- 2. The disciples and Apostles did not fully understand Christ until they understood the Old Testament (e.g., Luke 24:44-53)
- 3. The Apostles and early prophets based their preaching of Christ on the Old Testament (e.g., Acts 2:16-36, Acts 8:34-35)

Acts 8:34–35 ³⁴The eunuch answered Philip and said, "Please *tell me*, of whom does the prophet say this? Of himself or of someone else?" ³⁵Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning from this Scripture he preached Jesus to him.

Reasons for Studying Christ in the Old Testament

- 1. Christ Himself declared that He is revealed in the Old Testament (e.g., Matthew 22:41-46, John 5; Luke 4; Luke 16; Luke 24)
- 2. The disciples and Apostles did not fully understand Christ until they understood the Old Testament (e.g., Luke 24:44-53)
- 3. The Apostles and early prophets based their preaching of Christ on the Old Testament (e.g., Acts 2:16-36, Acts 8:34-35)
- 4. The Apostles and their associates grounded their New Testament writings in the Old Testament (e.g., Roman 3:10-18)

Ways Christ Is Seen in the Old Testament

1. Prophecies

• These are prophecies written by prophets about the coming person and work of Messiah

2. Types and Shadows (Typology)

- These are people, events, or institutions that serve as dim images or patterns of the greater reality found in Christ
- They pre-figure Jesus' life, death, and work

3. Christophanies

• These are pre-incarnate, physical appearances of the Son of God

Luke 24:27 Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.


Luke 24:45 Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures

Jesus' Revelation on the Road to Emmaus

Luke 24:13-32

On the road to Emmaus (13-27)

- Later that day, two disciples travel to the village of Emmaus and discuss all that has taken place (vv13-14)
- Jesus joins them, but they do not recognize Him (vv15-16)
- Jesus asks what they are talking about, and they are amazed that He seems unaware of what has taken place (vv17-19a)
- The disciples explain Jesus, including the reports of His resurrection (vv19b-24)
- Jesus explains Himself to the disciples, including how all that has taken place was prophesied in the Old Testament concerning Messiah (vv25-27)




Jesus' Revelation on the Road to Emmaus

Luke 24:13-32

Jesus' Revelation on the Road to Emmaus

Luke 24:13-32

On the road to Emmaus (13-27)

At the village of Emmaus (28-32)

- The disciples invite Jesus to stay with them (28-29)
- While sharing a meal together, the disciples come to recognize Jesus (30-31a)
- Jesus then vanishes (31b)
- The disciples speak of how their hearts burned while He explain Scriptures (32)

Jesus' Revelation to Disciples in Jerusalem

Luke 24:33-49

In a room in Jerusalem (33-49)

- The two disciples return to Jerusalem and explain what happened with Jesus (33-35)
- Jesus then appears, but they were doubting (36-38)
- Jesus demonstrates that He has a real, physical body (39-43)
- Jesus reminds them how all things written about Him in the Old Testament must be fulfilled (44)
- Jesus then opened their minds to understand the Scriptures (45-48)
- Jesus instructs them to stay in the city until the coming of the Holy Spirit (49)

Jesus' Ascension

Luke 24:50-53

At Bethany (50-53)

- Jesus blesses them and then ascends to heaven (50-51)
- The people worship Jesus with great joy and continually praise God (52-53)

Closing Reflections

- Jesus Himself, the Apostles, and the entire New Testament all compel us to study Christ in the Old Testament
- Pray that the Lord would prepare and open your mind and heart to understand and embrace how the Old Testament speaks of Christ
- May this study cause you to see the glory, beauty, and majesty of Christ in the Old Testament and cause your heart to be set on fire for Him
- May this study cause you to overflow with great joy and praise in worship of Christ, our perfect Messiah!
