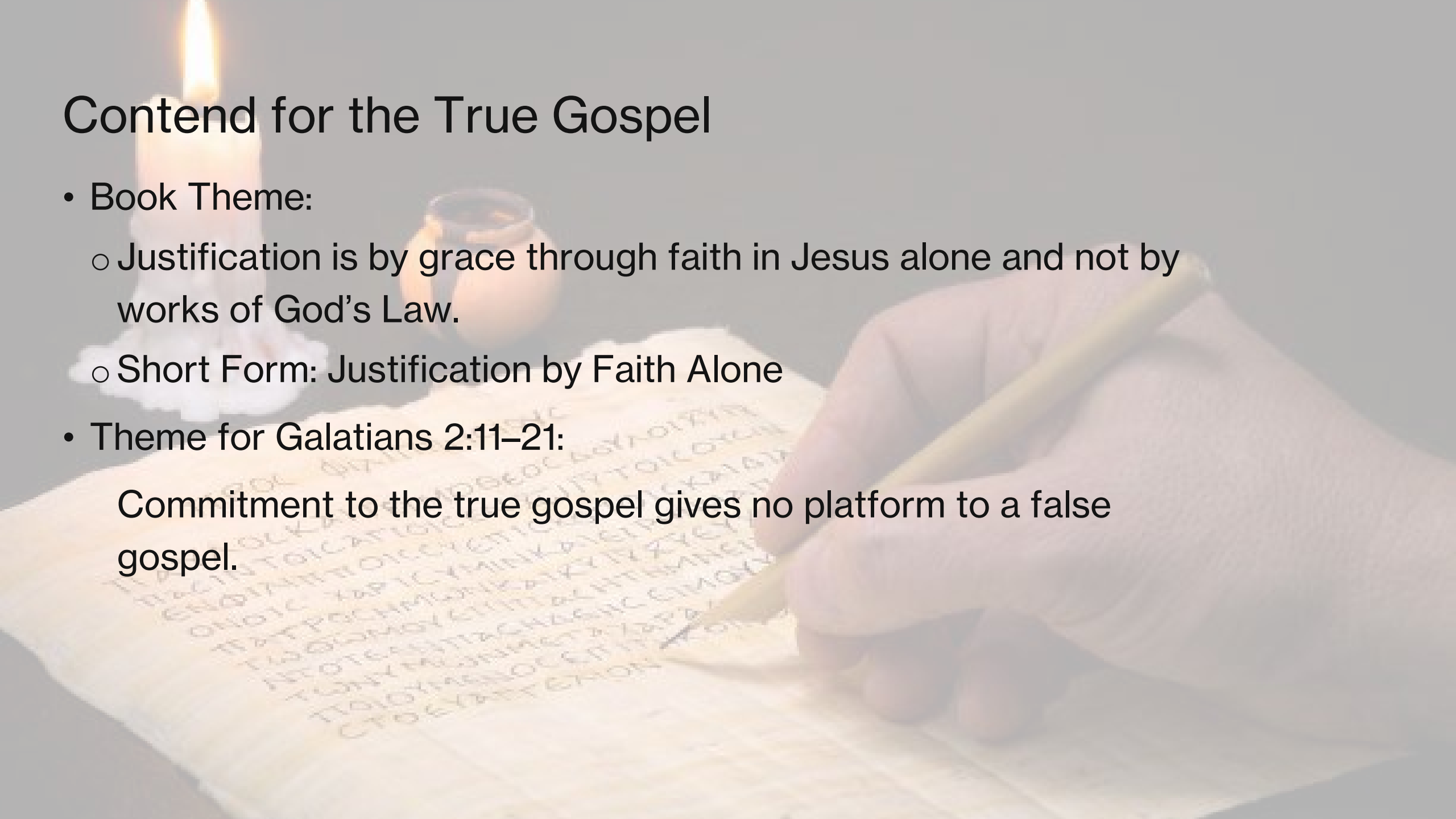

Contend for the True Gospel

- Book Theme:
 - Justification is by grace through faith in Jesus alone and not by works of God's Law.
 - Short Form: Justification by Faith Alone
- Theme for Galatians 2:11–21:

Commitment to the true gospel gives no platform to a false gospel.

Contend for the True Gospel

I. Confront the False Gospel Boldly (11–14)

- A. Fear of Man Mars Integrity (11–12)

II. Proclaim the True Gospel Clearly (15–21)

4. Cherish the gospel of justification by faith in Christ alone (Gal 2:11–21).
