Book Theme: Justification by Faith Alone

Book Theme Verse: Galatians 2:16 - Nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus.

Passage Theme Statement: The apostle Paul confronts the apostle Peter for physically supporting the Judaizers position that salvation includes the works of the Law. The apostle Paul then refutes that position and clearly presents the true doctrine that salvation is by faith alone in Christ alone.

Passage Key Verse: Galatians 2:20 - ²⁰"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.
