Popular, Bad Ideas about Christian Influence

- 1. The church can best influence unbelievers by contextualization.
- 2. The church can best influence the culture through *political action*.
- 3. The *main goal* of the believer's influence is to make the planet, our country, and our communities better.
- 4. We shouldn't care about our influence on the world but just focus on our personal devotion to Jesus.

- I. The Picture Jesus Uses (13a)
 - A. A Seasoning for Food (Job 6:6)
 - B. A Cleanser or Antiseptic (Ezek. 16:4)
 - C. A Preservative
- II. The Point Jesus Makes (13a)
- III. The Peril Jesus Exposes (13b-c)
 - A. The sin in our lives reduces our preserving influence.
 - B. The lack of preserving influence proves we're not Jesus' followers.

- 2. Be who you are in Jesus Christ (Jn. 17:17).
- 3. Live out the Beatitudes (Mt. 5:3-9).
