

TWO TYPES OF LAWS...


- 1. <u>Apodictic Law</u> is absolute and clearly states a command or prohibition. These are the "thou shall/ thou shall nots" of the law.
- 2. <u>Casuistic Law</u> is the case-based law. It takes into consideration certain circumstances. Usually these are laws that have "*If a man…then*"
