- Affirm Jesus' Relationship to Scripture (17)
 - A. He Did Not Come to *Abolish* the OT (17a)
 - B. He Came to *Fulfill* the OT (17b)
 - 1. He perfectly explained its meaning in His teaching (21-48)
 - 2. He perfectly obeyed its commands in His life (Mt. 3:15; Jn. 8:46; 15:10; Gal. 4:4-5)
 - 3. He perfectly embodied its message in His Person
 - a. Its prophecies (11:7-15)
 - b. Its ceremonies & sacrificial system (Lk. 24:27, 44; Jn. 5:39; Col. 2:16-17; Heb. 10:1-12)

- II. Adopt Jesus' View of Scripture (18)
 - A. Its Permanent Authority "until heaven and earth pass away"
 - B. Its Verbal Inspiration "not the smallest letter or stroke"

"Not the Smallest Letter or Stroke"

- Lit., "One yōta or one little horn, no not at all shall pass away."
- "Smallest letter"
 - In Greek
 - Its name is "iωτα", pronounced yōta.
 - It resembles our lower case "i".
 - It's equivalent to the English letter "I".
 - In <u>Hebrew</u>
 - Its name is "yodh", pronounced yōth.
 - It's equivalent to English "Y".
 - It looks like our apostrophe:
 - > 66,000 *yodhs* in the OT
 - Jesus says, "Not one shall pass!"

"Not the Smallest Letter or Stroke"

- Lit., "One yōta or one little horn, no not at all shall pass away."
- "Stroke"
 - Lit., "little horn"
 - The small pen stroke or projection that distinguishes one Hebrew letter from another
 - Cf. the English capitals of O and Q
 - **1** [beth] vs. **2** [kaf]
 - **P**[*daleth*] vs. **¬** [*resh*]
 - Jesus says, "Not one of those small marks or projections will pass away, lose its force, or become invalid."
