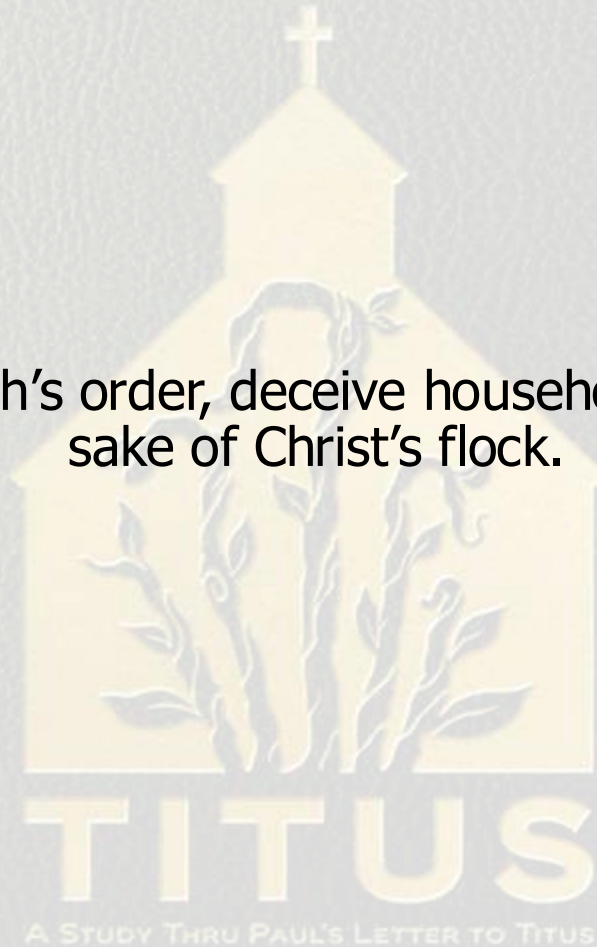

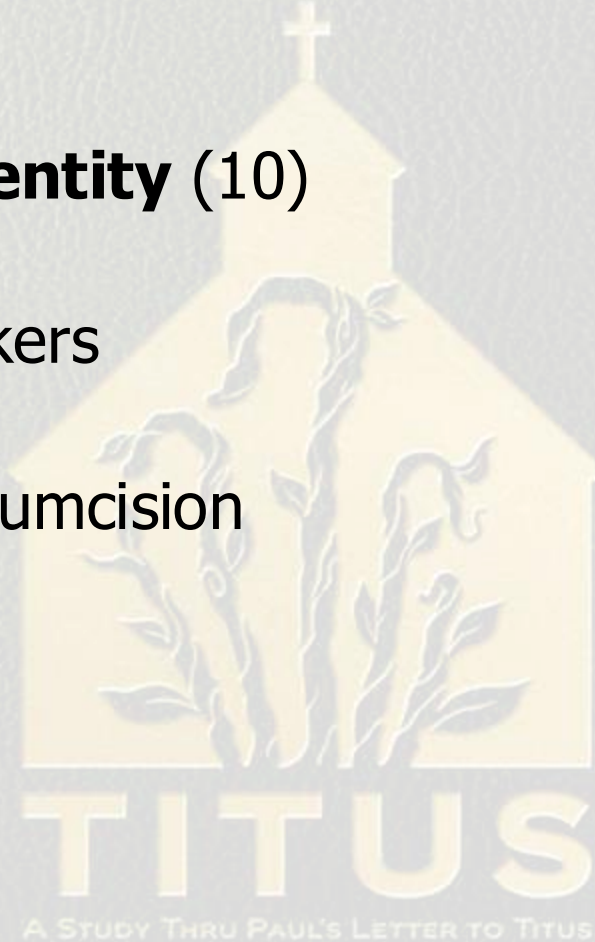
Lesson Theme:

False teachers destroy the church's order, deceive households, and must be silenced for the sake of Christ's flock.



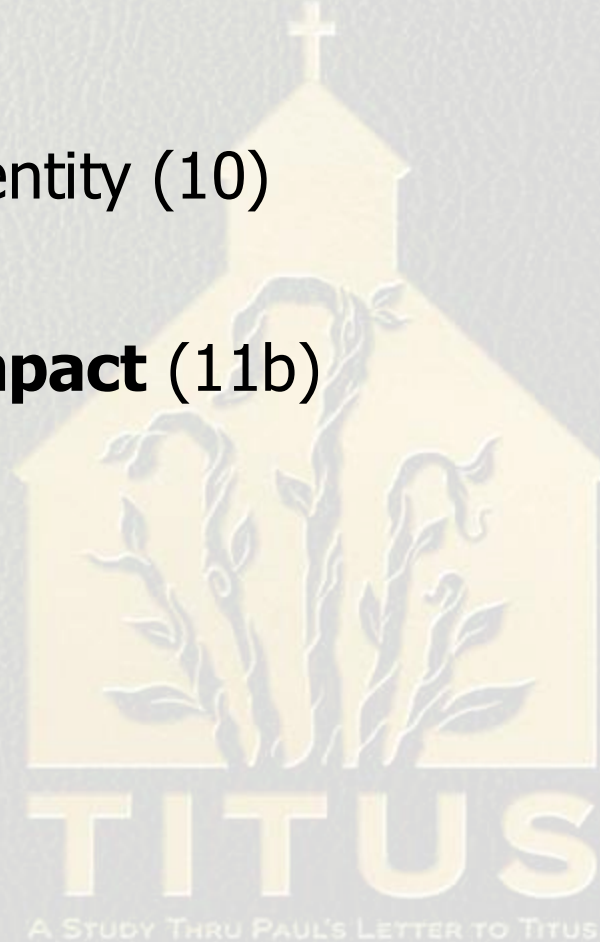

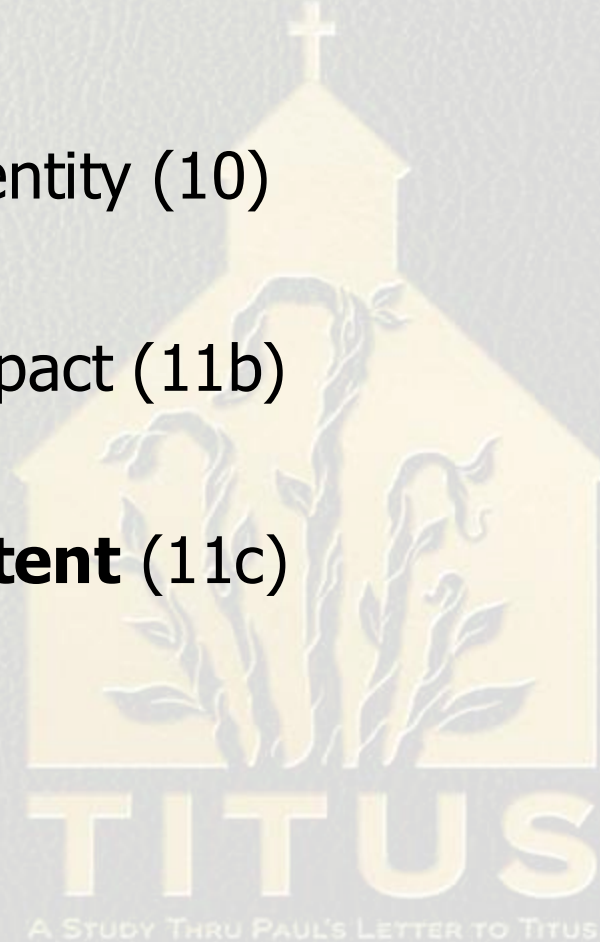

1. By Faithful Teaching of God's Word (Tit. 2:1; 2 Cor. 10:5)
2. By Rebuking False Teachers Directly (Tit. 1:13)
3. By Restricting their access to Teaching Platforms (1 Tim. 1:3)
4. By Warning the Flock Publicly (Acts 20:31)
5. By Marking and Avoiding Them (Rom. 16:17-18)
6. By Applying Discipline When Necessary (Matt. 18:15-17)
7. By Strengthening the Church through Ongoing Discipleship (Tit. 1:9; Matt. 28:19-20)
