THEME: For every believer, praise is the only appropriate response for the blessings God has given us in Christ.

Some Initial Observations

- Verses 3-14 form just one sentence in the Greek
- This passage is filled with expressions of praise
- The passage is challenging to outline
- Paul opens with with an exclamation of praise to God (3)
- The reason for our praise: God has blessed us (3b)
- Aspects of God's blessing of us
 - We received His blessings at the moment of salvation
 - He has given us every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places
 - We receive them in Christ

- 1. Election (4)
 - a. The reality of God's sovereign choice
 - i. God chose us, we didn't choose Him
 - ii. Election is individual and personal
 - iii. Election is in Christ
 - iv. Election is unconditional
 - b. God's purpose in election (4b)
