Council of Chalcedon (451 AD)

"Following, then, the holy Fathers, we all with one voice teach the confession of one and the same Son, our Lord Jesus Christ: the same perfect in Godhead and also perfect in manhood; truly God and truly man, of a reasonable soul and body; consubstantial with the Father according to the Godhead, and consubstantial with us according to the Manhood; in all things like unto us, without sin."

 - 1. This paragraph is here to convince you of who Jesus is and that you should believe in Him (20:30-31).
 - 2. If you come to Him, Jesus will receive you (1:10-13).
- If you <u>are</u> a follower of Jesus...
 - 1. The incarnation is a powerful reminder of your duty to share the gospel with others (Mt. 5:15-16; Phil. 2:15).
 - 2. The incarnation is a powerful reminder of God's love for you (1 Jn. 4:9-10)!
