Implications from the Tabernacle Build

- 1. We must live faithfully according to the instructions given by God's word and not according to our own notion of what God wants.
- 2. Considering the truth that God desires communion with His people, our lives should reflect obedience to the Great Commandment. (Matt.22:37-39)
- 3. God has always had a redemptive plan for His true followers and has made a way through Christ Jesus that we can finally dwell with Him forever. (Eph.1:4-5; Heb.9:11-12)
