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- How does Genesis 3:15 function as the “prototype” of the gospel, and why is that important for understanding the rest of Scripture?
  - If Scripture teaches the availability of God’s Word is a blessing (Rom. 3:1-2) and its absence is a judgment (Amos 8:11-12), how should that shape your devotion and delight in the Word?
  - How does Acts 2 echo and reverse the events of Genesis 11? What does this reveal about God’s heart for you, a gentile?
  - If God ministers through the church according to His plan and His power, how should that help you minister in your circles? What are some reasons you struggle with trusting God’s plan and/or power when ministering to loved ones?
  - What is the difference between being baptized in the Spirit and filled by the Spirit?
  - What was the purpose of tongues and how do we know that it was human language rather than ecstatic utterances? In being filled by the Spirit through the spiritual disciplines (Prayer/Scripture/Worship/Fellowship), should you be seeking the gift of tongues? Why or why not?
  - What should you be pursuing instead?
  - How do you fulfill the mission of the church, revealing Christ a hopeless world?
