
# GOD'S PLAN CONCERNING CONSECRATION

  - Completion of His good work







## LESSONS

- I. Believers have been sanctified through the once-for-all sacrifice of Christ, who by a single offering has perfected those who are being sanctified. (Heb. 10:8-10,14; 13:12; 7:25)
- II. Believers are being sanctified by living according to the truth from God's word. (John 17:17, 19)
- III. Believers will be fully and completely sanctified when our future glory is received in the new heaven and earth. (1 Thess.5:23-24; 1 John 3:2-3; Phil.3:20-21)
