

“Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.”

Titus 3:5 -

“He saved us not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit.”

1ST John 1:7-9 -

John 5:24 –

“Truly, truly, I say to you, He who hears My words, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgement, but has passed out of death into life.”

1st John 1:8-9 -

vs 8 “If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

1st Corinthians 3:1-3 -

I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able to receive it indeed even now you are not yet able, for you are still fleshly. For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly and are you not walking like mere men?”

Ephesians 4:1-3 -

“Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, with all humility, and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”

Spurgeon –
