

## II. Dedication: Ingredients for Anointing Oil (22-33)

- Command (22-24)

## FINE SPICES

### ☑ Myrrh – 12.5 lbs

- A sap-like resin sourced from a Commiphora tree.
- Native to lands of Egypt and China.
- Fragrant in aroma with smoky, balsamic notes.



## FINE SPICES

### ☑ Cinnamon – 6.25 lbs

- A spice from dried inner bark of a Cinnamomum tree.
- Native to lands of India, Sri Lanka and China.
- Fragrant in aroma with warm, spicy notes.



## FINE SPICES

☑ Cane (Calamus) – 6.25 lbs

- A marsh plant.
- Indigenous to Asia and Eastern Europe.
- The flower is sweet in smell, while the root has warm, spicy undertones.



## FINE SPICES

- ✓ Cassia – 12.25 lbs
  - Collected from the inner bark of a Cassia tree.
  - Indigenous to Asia and Indochina.
  - Strong in its woody, spicy smell.

# Three Ways we must live...

1. **Purification** – Believers are called to pursue holiness by living according to the truth of God’s word which purifies us. (Jn.17:17; 2 Cor.7:1)
2. **Dedication** – A redeemed life is one wholly devoted to the glory of Christ. (Rom.12:1; 1 Cor.10:31)
3. **Intercession** – God calls His people to continually approach Him in prayer. (1 Tim.2:1; Eph.6:18)
