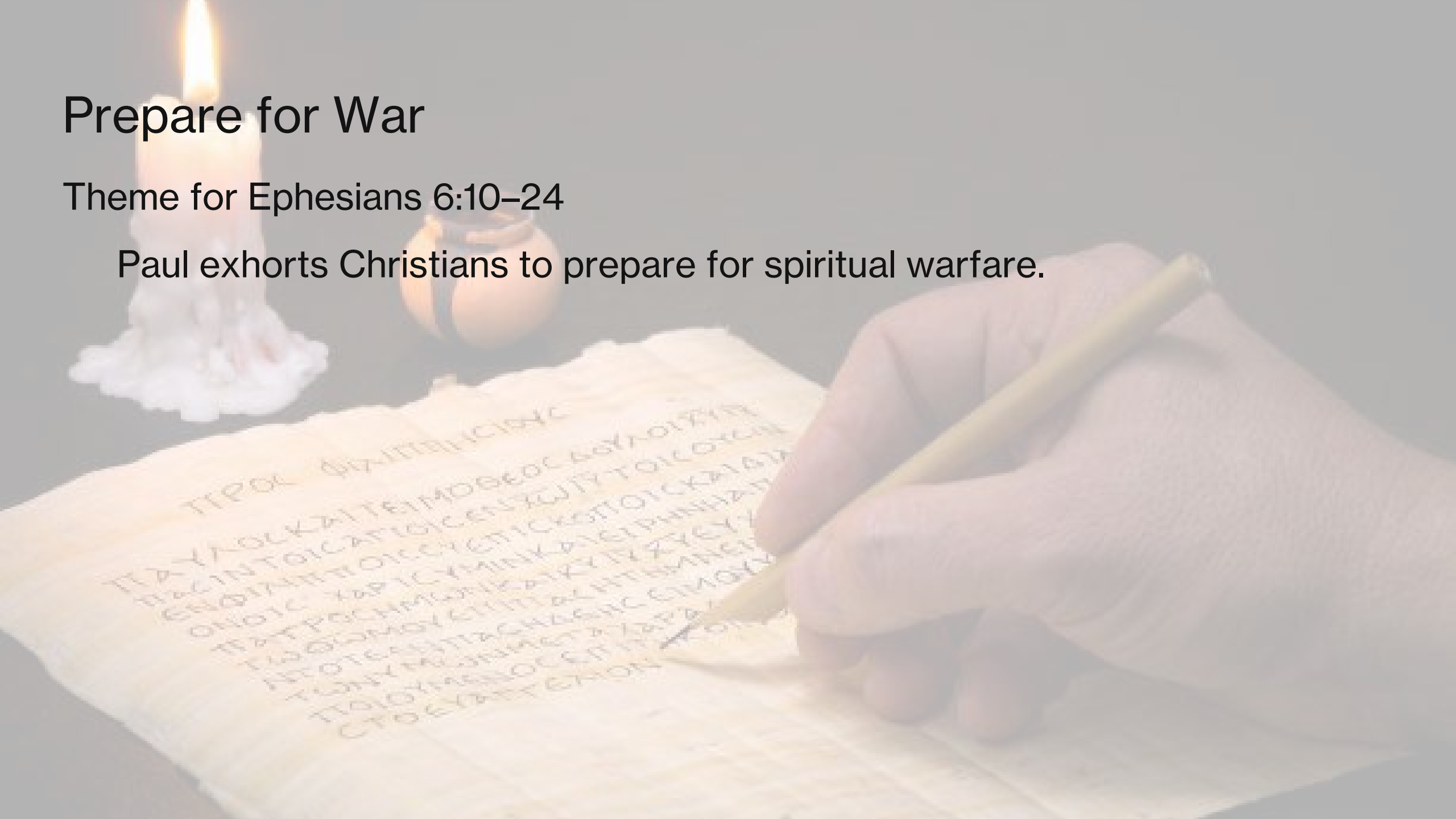

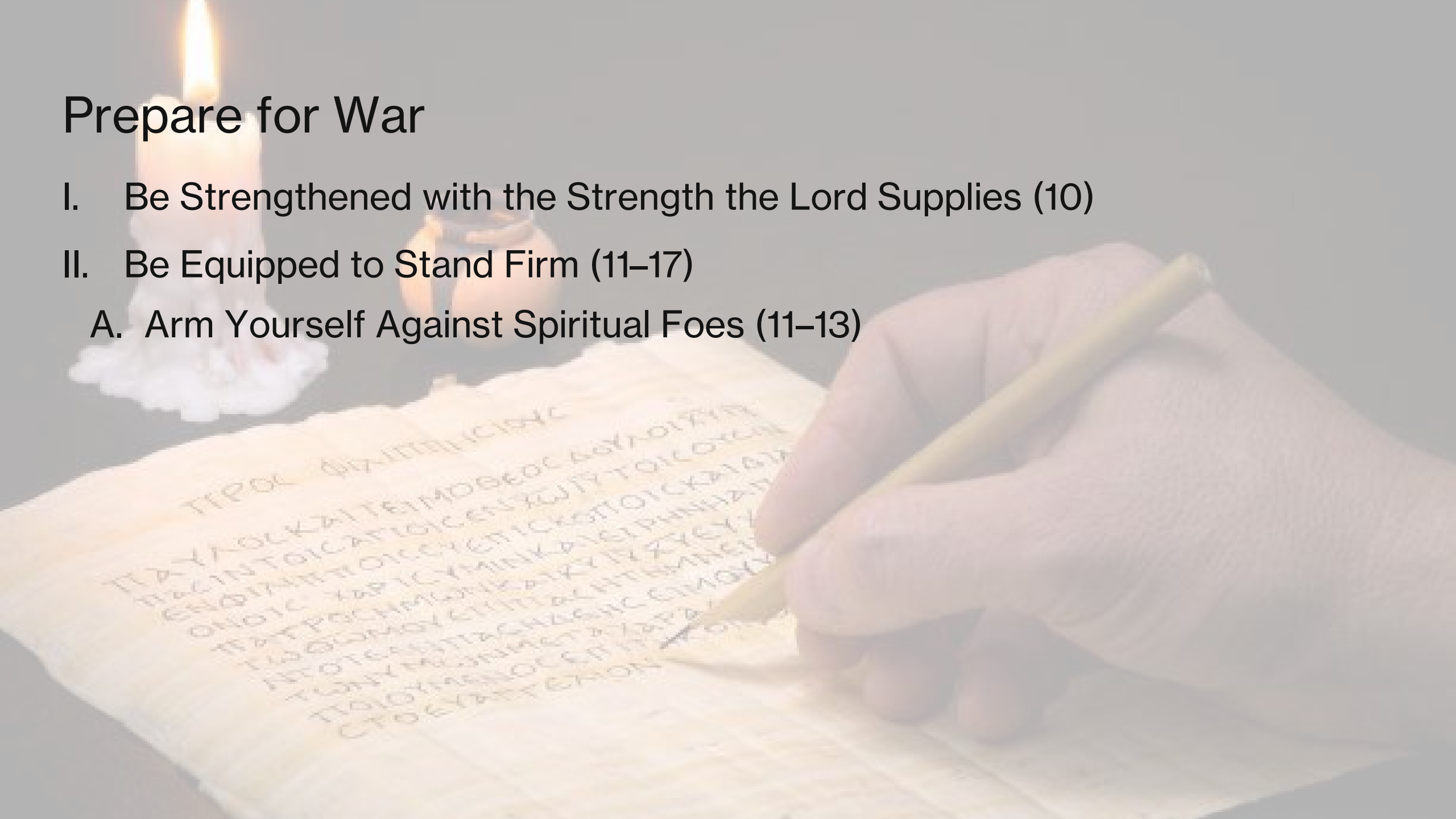
Theme for Ephesians 6:10–24
