# Introduction

---

- Psalm 8 is prophetic and Christ-centered Lk 24:44–49
  - All things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and **the Psalms must be fulfilled.**
  - Psalm 8 presents the greater Adam, Jesus Christ the savior
  - Psalm 8 - Quoted 4 times directly in NT about Jesus

# I. The Supreme Glory of God Declared (vv. 1, 9)

---

- A. The Covenant Name of God “LORD”
  - YHWH (self-existent, covenant God)
  - “our Lord” = Adonai (Master/Ruler) Scripture: Ex 3:14; Jn 8:58; Acts 2:36; Rom 10:9; burning bush / “I AM”



# “I AM” Claims by Christ

- John 8:58
  - “Before Abraham was, I AM.”
- “John 8:24
  - “unless you believe that I AM...”
- John 8:28
  - “you will know that I AM”
- John 13:19
  - “that you may believe that I AM”
- John 18:5–6
  - soldiers fall back when Jesus says “I AM”

*Jesus not only claims to be—He defines Himself as the source of life:*

- John 6:35
  - – “I am the bread of life”
- John 8:12
  - “I am the light of the world”
- John 10:11
  - “I am the good shepherd”
- John 11:25
  - “I am the resurrection and the life”
- John 14:6
  - “I am the way, the truth, and the life”
- John 15:1
  - “I am the true vine”

# APPLICATIONS

---

1. Christ as the True Man – Where Adam failed, Christ was successful
    - a. Psalm 8 is not ultimately about generic humanity
    - b. It is about Christ as the perfect Son of Man
  2. Every Day we should see Gods creation and glorify Him for it
  3. Praise God daily for He is worthy -even of the praise of children
  4. Jesus took on flesh to save you
    - a. If you are believer, Praise the Lord for your salvation that he was mindful of you
    - b. If you are not a believer, Jesus came to die on the cross to redeem mankind, repent and believe in the only name by which you can be saved
  5. Jesus is the ultimate judge and his reign is forever
  6. See the majesty of the Great IAM and serve him as Lord and Master
