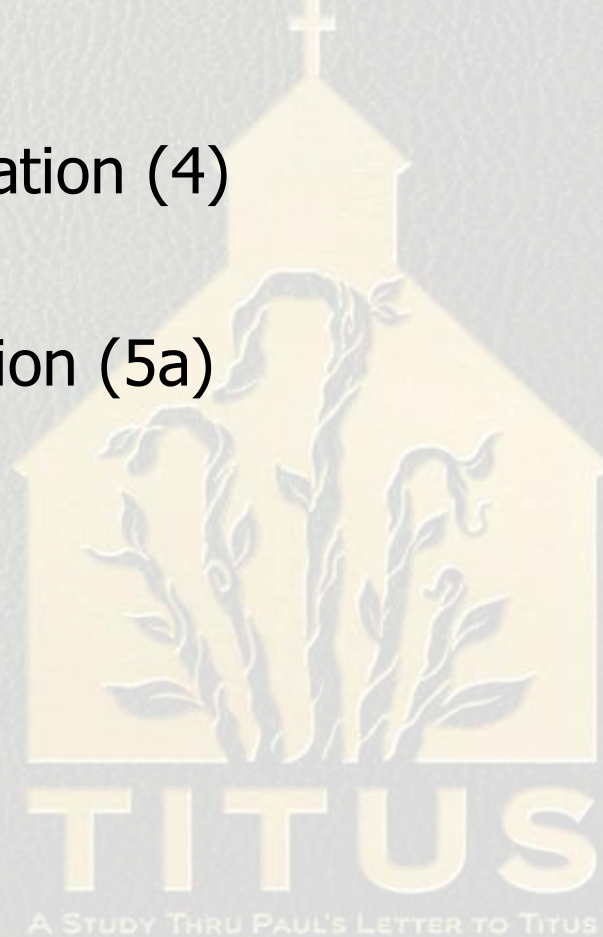

He Saved Us

Why Not Works?

1. Man is Guilty and Can Never Earn Righteousness (Rom. 3:23; Isa. 64:6)
2. Salvation is Grounded in Christ Alone (John 14:6; Eph. 2:8-9)
3. God Will Not Share His Glory (Eph. 2:8-9; Isa. 42:8; 48:11)
4. God Ordains our Works (Eph. 2:10)
