

# **Bear One Another's Temptations**

*Galatians 6:2*

June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026

**Theme:** Christian love is most clearly displayed when believers come alongside others who are burdened by sin.

Paul describes two aspects of Christian care, which should drive us to help fellow believers carry burdens too heavy to bear alone:

## **I. What We Must Do (vs. 2a)**

## **II. Why We Must Do It (vs. 2b)**

### *Questions for Meditation*

1. How does the context of Galatians 6:1-5 and church discipline/restoration inform our understanding of "bearing one another's burdens" in Galatians 6:2?
2. How does bearing burdens of others fulfill "the law of Christ"?
3. What impediments keep you from more readily bearing the burdens of other Christians?
4. Has this text challenged your typical approach to relating to Christians who are weighed down by temptation?
5. Is it prudent for Christians to "go it alone" when dealing with ongoing sin struggles? If not, why?
6. Can you share an instance where you were encouraged by another believer sharing your burdens?
