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I. Its Prediction Recorded in Jewish History (14–16)

A. The Source: Book of 1 Enoch (14a)

John 11:47–53

- In Caiaphas' case, God revealed truth through the *spoken* words of Caiaphas—and John, writing under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, says those words are true and prophetic.
- In the book of 1 Enoch, God revealed truth through the *written* words of the author of 1 Enoch, and Jude, writing under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, says those words are true and prophetic.

A. The Source: Book of 1 Enoch (14a)

i. Who is Enoch?

“The lack of information about Enoch’s “walk with God” and disappearance attracted special attention in later Judaism and earned him a place of honor in several lists of Jewish ancestors.”
